



MSM who top sometimes think that they cannot catch HIV from a bottom. Here is some information around how tops can become infected with HIV;

1) The urethral tube

You can be infected if your urethral tube is soaked in infectious fluids. Rectal secretions have 25 times more HIV in them than cum, even if someone is on effective HIV medication.

2) Untreated sexually-transmitted infections (STI) and/or untreated urinary tract infections

These can dramatically increase your risk of absorbing HIV by up to 5 times. Many STIs have no symptoms and infected persons may not know they have an STI. Often those who end up with HIV start out by getting Gonorrhea, Chlamydia and/or Herpes.

3) Uncut Foreskin

HIV passes through the cells in an uncut foreskin 2-3 times more easily than a circumcised foreskin and so the risk of infection is higher. Although circumcision reduces some transmission of HIV there is still no guarantee that HIV can enter your blood stream through your urethral tube or underneath the foreskin.
